### What happens at the Competition?

- Teams will present their long-term solution in an 8-minute skit to the judges, spectators are encouraged!
- Teams will compete in a spontaneous problem. Coaches and parents are NOT permitted in the room for the spontaneous portion of the competition (this is the rule every year).
- At the end of competition day, the WPAOM will hold a sock hop and awards ceremony in the High School Gym.

### Team Requirements:

- 5-7 Students per team (no exceptions!)
- One coach required—you may have multiple coaches.
- Each team is required to have one volunteer and two judges.

### Division Breakdown: (The oldest student on the team determines the division in which the team will compete)

- Primary—Kindergarten-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade – Competes in the regional competition ONLY.
- Division I—3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade ~ Division II—6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grade ~ Division III—9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade  
*Division 1-3 have the opportunity to advance to the state and world competitions.*

### Practices:

- Practice should be held weekly (and more as the competition gets closer) but ultimately your team decides when/where/how often.
- Practices can be held at home, public spaces (that you have permission to use), online, or at the school (see website for permit requests as well as guidelines for school use for practices)
- Team Spontaneous practices will be held throughout the season and run by the coordinator and other parent/coach volunteers. *Dates are still TBD.* Once dates are available, I will post them on the website and notify coaches and registered families.

### Note to Parents:

- STUDENTS MUST BE AVAILABLE FOR THE COMPETITION TO PARTICIPATE!!
- Support your coach! You can: volunteer for the competition, train to be a judge or help at practices.

### Costs:

- Registration payments are due November 15, 2024. Registration is \$75 per student in division 1-3 and \$50 per student in the primary division.  
*Registration payments are used for regional competition fees, membership fees, spontaneous fun day registration, coach stipend, and competition t-shirts.*
- Coach receives up to a \$50 stipend for materials (when receipt is presented). All other expenses are the responsibility of the team.
- Students moving onto the State Final and World Final Competitions will have additional costs TBD.
